Education Advisory Group

March 26, 2024—9:30 A.M.

Opening

Director Greg Lemon convened a meeting of the Education Advisory Group at 9:32 a.m. on March 26, 2024, VIA Zoom.

Approval of Minutes from 01/09/2024

The minutes of the Education Advisory Group held on January 9, 2024, were considered. After review, a motion was made by Leighun Brabec to approve the minutes as presented. The Group voted unanimously to approve the minutes.

Introductions

Melissa Belcastro, new Deputy Director for Education with the Commission, was introduced to the group. New member and Director of Education for the Nebraska Realtors, Jennie Flores, was introduced as well.

Review Recommendations for Revised Pre-license Education Requirements

Director Lemon explained the Commission's proposal to make the Nebraska License Law class and Principles and Practices Mandatory pre-license education, as well as adding an additional 30-hour requirement to pre-license education for an elective course. The Advisory Group discussed the proposal. While there was not a consensus on support or opposition to the proposal, a number of other ideas were expressed as possible ways to enhance education and training for licensees. These enhancements included additional education for brokers, a formalized apprenticeship or mentoring program, making Principles and Practices a 40-hour course instead of 30 hours, increase CE requirements significantly, having a mandatory core class developed by the Commission and required every two years.

Summer 2024 Instructor Development Workshop

Deputy Director Belcastro solicited input on the agenda and subject matter for the 2024 Instructor Development Workshop. It was noted that the past few years had put an emphasis on keeping remote learners engaged. It was suggested that more emphasis be placed on best practices for classroom education for the next IDW. Another point of emphasis noted was generational differences in the instructors and students, and making sure proper teaching methods are used to keep younger students engaged.

Education Exam Update

Director Lemon noted that a revised exam form was implemented on February 29th, and the pass rated under the new exam would be monitored and shared when available.

NAR Commission Lawsuit Settlement

Director Lemon spoke about the proposed NAR lawsuit settlement regarding commission splits and agency requirements. Director Lemon noted he saw nothing in the license act that would be required to be changed under the settlement, but that custom and practice in agency and commission splits may change significantly, and those changes may require current courses to be revised.

New business

There was no new business offered for consideration.

Adjourn

At 10:59 a.m., there being no further business to discuss, the group voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting.
