Core Requirements (Simplified)

- Providers must be approved by the Commission before offering courses
- Courses and instructors must meet state standards and approval processes
- Documentation and forms must be submitted for:
 - Providers
 - Courses
 - Instructors
 - Significant changes must be reported
- Providers must comply with ongoing reporting and updates
